  - Oxygen Cylinder (Portable) with Oxygen Pressure Reducer (10 L, 1 unit)
  - Jumbo Oxygen Cylinder - 47.5 L (1 Unit)
  - Scoop Stretcher
  - Spine Board
  - Wheel Chair
- The project distributed oxygen concentrators in multiple cities.

## 03 Key Impact

- Ambulance distribution improved emergency response, reducing patient transport times during health crises.
- Strengthened medical support infrastructure alleviated strain on healthcare facilities, enabling more efficient patient care.
- Oxygen cylinder provision alleviated the challenges beneficiaries face dealing with health issues or having family members affected during crises.
- Reduced stress levels among beneficiaries, enabling them to better focus on their work responsibilities and maintain productivity.
