Modi. "The scheme will provide universal health insurance cover to all the citizens of Jammu and Kashmir thereby ensuring financial security during any medical exigency," the general insurer said in a statement on Monday.

Under the PMJAY-SEHAT, all citizens of the Union Territory, irrespective of their economic strata will be eligible for this scheme and can access med-

ical treatment across the country. Over 20 lakh families of Jammu and Kashmir will be covered under the scheme.

The sum insured of the policy is Rs ₹5 lakh and the health insurance will be provided on family floater basis.

This scheme will provide free of cost insurance to the J&K citizens and the premium of the same will be borne by the government.
